MAD-ID Members In The Literature: Dr. Ashlan Kunz-Coyne

Dr. Kunz-Coyne, along with MAD-ID member coauthors **Drs. Anthony Casapao** and **Christopher Jankowski** recently published their study entitled "Effectiveness and Safety of Beta-Lactam Antibiotics with and without Therapeutic Drug Monitoring in Patients with Pseudomonas aeruginosa Pneumonia or Bloodstream Infection" in Antimicrobial Agents and Chemotherapy.

In their study, Dr. Kunz-Coyne and colleagues ask the question: "Does beta lactam therapeutic drug monitoring (TDM) affect outcomes in patients with Pseudomonas aeruginosa pneumonia and bacteremia?"

The conducted a retrospective, parallel cohort study in two academic medical centers. After analyzing outcomes in 200 patients, they found that **beta lactam TDM was associated with reduced treatment failure** compared to no beta lactam TDM.

Check out her study: Impact of a Monthly Antimicrobial Stewardship Quality Assurance Tool for Elevated Vancomycin Levels published in Antimicrobial Stewardship and Healthcare Epidemiology

In this multicenter, retrospective, before-andafter implementation study, Dr. Knack and colleagues found that a monthly quality assurance tool for elevated vancomycin levels resulted in improved dosing and monitoring practices and enhanced patient safety.

Currently, Dr. Knack is an infectious diseases clinical pharmacist specialist at AdventHealth Tampa.
