MAD-ID Member Highlight: Allison Cid

We are excited to feature recent publications from former abstract presenters at the 2022 Annual MAD-ID Meeting.

Today we feature Allison Cid, former PGY2 ID pharmacy resident at The Ohio State University Wexner Medical Center.

Check out her study: **Impact of Concomitant Fluconazole on Direct Oral Anticoagulant Bleeding Risk** published in *Pharmacotherapy*!

In this study, Dr. Cid and colleagues found that patients receiving concomitant DOAC (apixaban or rivaroxaban) and fluconazole therapy were not at significantly increased risk for bleeding at 30 days

compared with a DOAC alone. This is a welcome addition to the literature given limited data on DOAC interactions with fluconazole.

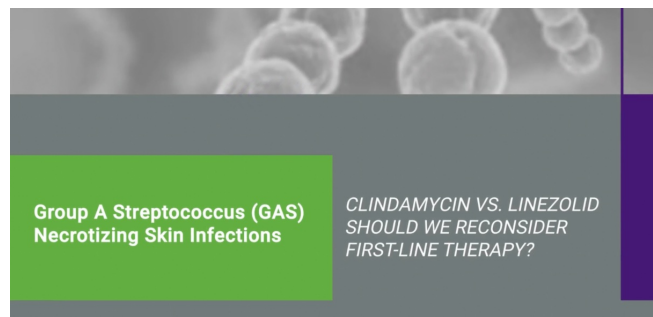
